

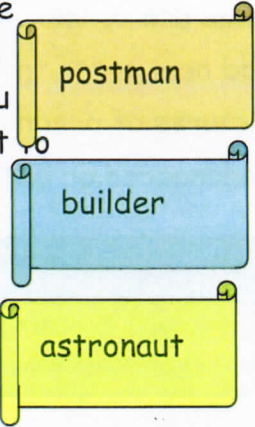

What do you want to be when you grow up?

We would also like your child to draw a picture of what they want to be and label the clothes and equipment they would need.

- What do you need to do to reach your job aspiration? (*work hard, practise, never give up, go to college and university*)
- Can you name any dangerous jobs? Why are they dangerous? (*firefighter, police officer*)
