Dear Parents/Carers,

I am really looking forward to seeing you all in September, we have really missed you!

It has been a pleasure welcoming some Reception, Year 1, Year 5 and Year 6 children back to school. They have been amazing and coped really well being in their bubbles.

I am sure you are aware that we now have the guidance telling us how school will look in September and I am thrilled to be able to write to you and let you know what Little Bloxwich will be like in September.

Firstly let me re-assure you that all guidance from the Government and Public Health England is being and will continue to be followed fully. This means the school is being cleaned more regularly throughout the day and tables, door handles and toilets are all cleaned regularly throughout the day.

Staff and children are expected to wash their hands on entry to the building, before and after any food and at other times. Hand Sanitizer is also available in all classrooms. We are still supervising how children wash their hands and reminding them about good hygiene.

All classrooms have tissues available and lidded bins to dispose of these in.

All children will be part of a class bubble which means those children stay together and do not mix with other children. This means we have staggered starts and finishes to the day. I am aware this might mean parents have to wait around to drop off/pick up siblings. I know this isn't ideal but please bear with us as we are following guidance and keeping each other safe. The children will also have staggered lunch and play times.

We will be providing bagels/toast and lunches, however we won't be running the menu system as it is not practical. Lunches will be eaten in the children's classrooms meaning they won't mix with another bubble, their meals will be brought to them. Sandwich boxes will be allowed back into school in September for those children who bring sandwiches. Please make sure these are wiped down inside and outside every day.
