Task 1: Verbally retell part of a story- Read the final two chapters of the book (pages 19-32) then verbally retell the story to an adult.

Task 2: Write sentences using fronted adverbials- Re-read the story to recap what has happened then write some sentences about the story, each beginning with a fronted adverbial. E.g. *All of a sudden, bright green heat-seeking gel boomerangs appeared out of nowhere!* Remember after each fronted adverbial you need a comma. Make your sentences as interesting as possible, including adjectives and detail. Here are some fronted adverbials you can use, you can also think of your own.

Before long, As quick as he/she could, In the blink of an eye, Inside the spaceship,
In the distance, Unexpectedly, Bravely, Frantically, Almost unbelievably,
Perfectly confident, Without warning, Immediately, Behind the viewscreen,

Task 3- Write questions and hot seating activity- Imagine you are going to interview the character 'Max' about the mission they have just faced- write questions you would like to ask him. E.g. How did you feel when Krool I said "Surrender or be destroyed"?
