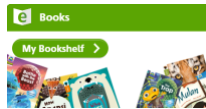

Feel free to read other books on the site.

**Monday** – read the book with an adult.

– Look at the green words and try to “Fred talk” them to read, then have a go at reading the red words.

–Talk about the book and list the things that you can do to help save the planet.

**Tuesday** - read the book again.

-Focus on the vocabulary words at the beginning of the book and try to find them in the text.

-Then try to write a sentence with the words in.

**E.g. Harmful.....**

**It is harmful to throw rubbish away.**

***Y1 ENGLISH TASK Week3&4 – Based around the book OUR INCREDIBLE PLANET***

**Wednesday** - look at page 13, think about the text.

-Write a sentence for each picture – remember say the sentence first before writing it.

**What does a sentence need? Capital letter, full stop and spaces between words.**

**CHALLENGE – write a sentence using and or because to connect 2 ideas.**

**Thursday** - Comprehension and understanding. – look at the questions to read, answer and chat about

-Talk through the answers and practice going back to the text to find where it says.

Can you write some questions about the book for someone else to answer?

REMEMBER – question starts –WHAT HOW WHY and a question mark?

**E.g. What are 2 ways that children can help?**

**Friday** –

- Read the book again – are you getting quicker and more fluent?

- Make something using recycled materials

Can you write instructions so someone else could make it?

First .....Then.....Next... Lastly.....

**First you collect the materials.**

### Additional activities associated to the book.

1. Write a book review for your favourite book or a book from Oxford Owl.
2. Use a dictionary to find the meaning of unknown words.
3. Practice spelling the green and red words and test yourself on Friday.
4. Create a paper mache globe and draw the countries on you have visited.
