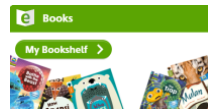

Read the story for enjoyment today - the children can have a go at reading or they can listen to the adult reading.

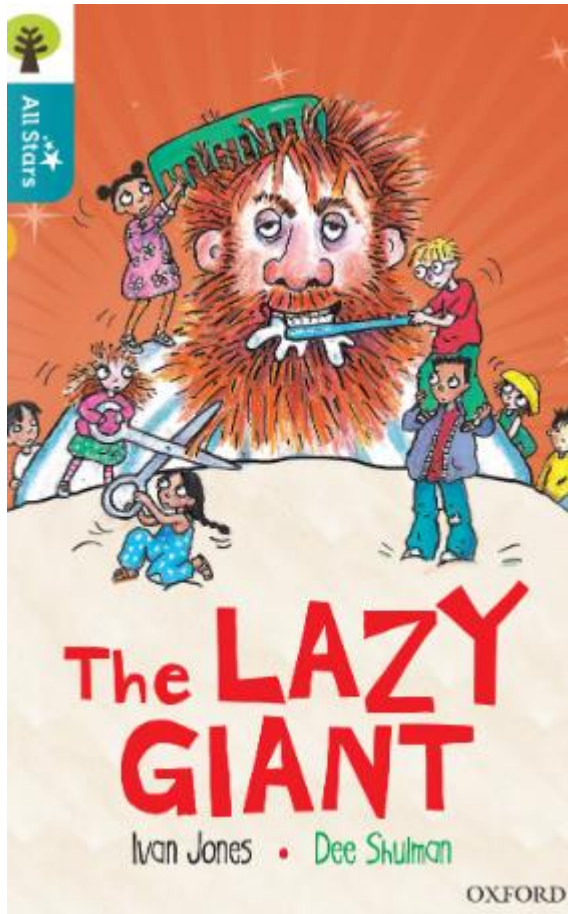
Purpose is to listen to the story so that they know what the book is about for future work related to it.
