Task 1: To make a prediction based on an image.

Below is an image taken from a short story clip that you will watch tomorrow. Using the image, write around it what you can see, what do you think you know already and what you predict will happen in the video;



Task 2: To visually read the text 'The Lighthouse'.

As you are watching, you will need to pause the film at several parts to have a discussion with a family member:

- Opening scene, discuss the setting and the title
- Pause the film after the lighthouse keeper slams the window shut - what does he think about the people outside the window having fun? Why does the author put this scene in?
- How does the creator build up the tension in the film?
- When the lighthouse keeper breaks the lamp, discuss possible outcomes.

Task 3: To describe the setting of 'The Lighthouse'.

Using the image below, brainstorm language to describe the setting, think about nouns, adjectives and adverbs.

HINT: Think about: the time, the weather, the physical environment, sounds, smells, feelings.



Task 4: To hot seat a character.
