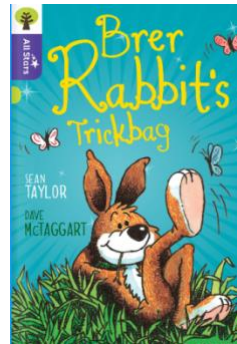

Task 2: (Tuesday) Read the end of the story again. Answer these true or false questions.


